



## HEAT TREATMENT PREPSHEET

-Pick up EVERYTHING from all floors and carpets including under the bed and closet. Toys, clothes, pillows, magazines should be off of the floor. Place all shoes in one area and throw the cardboard shoe box.

- Remove/strip bed sheets/linens, pillow cases, blankets and couch covers and wash them with warm water and dry on high heat
- Closets and drawers should not be overstuffed in order to ensure a proper heat treatment. If overstuffed, remove half of the contents of each drawer and closet and place in dryer according to label. After discarding old bags, place clothes into new bag and seal with tape.
- Vacuum/Sweep all floors

Remove from the treatment site the following items:

1. Persons, plants and animals.
2. Candles, wax items, crayons, lipstick and other meltable cosmetics.
3. Records, CDs, tapes (audio and video).
4. Computers and software disks.
5. Soft "Vinyl" plastic items like mini blinds.
6. "Arts and crafts" items that are assembled with hot melt glue.
7. Loose photographs (they may curl up).
8. Remote controls.
9. Aerosol cans and all other combustible items.
10. Musical instruments (they may de-tune due to expansion and contraction).
11. Magnets (like those used to hold notes on refrigerators).
12. Fresh fruits and vegetables, chocolates, carbonated beverages, wines and other liquors, artificial sweeteners, vitamins and medicines.
13. Glass bottles with liquids (they will pop)
14. Antique, laminate/composite wood furniture
15. Humidifiers and De-Humidifiers
16. Video game consoles and controls
17. Laptops (Leave behind the case)
18. Guns and live ammunition

In lieu of removal, small items may be placed in a refrigerator. Remove batteries from smoke detectors.
